# What's Coming in Planview Projectplace – Q1 2019

Happy New Year to all our Planview Projectplace® users! In 2018 we updated many of the core features of Projectplace® and in 2019 we plan to continue to strengthen the user experience and feature sets of Boards, Documents and all the other collaborative aspects of Projectplace. A summary of what you can expect in the first quarter of the year is listed below:

## Multiple People on a Card

Being one of the most voted-for Ideas in Projectplace, we have seen that there is a great need for people to show that they are working together to complete a card. It is therefore with great pleasure we announce that we will make it possible to assign a card to more than one person – promoting the collaborative aspect of Projectplace even further. This feature is scheduled for release in February 2019.

## People Management on the Account Level

In our journey to modernize the Account Administration module, the time has come for a much-anticipated uplift of the People page. Just as with the new Workspace page, we'll introduce a modern list view with better sorting mechanisms, a whole new filtering capability as well as more options for managing a selection of members at the same time. Managing the members of your account will become much easier with this update in the March release!

## Document Version Management

In our recent Document Survey, enhanced capabilities for version management came out as one of the top three requested features. We plan to release two new updates to document version management in Q1. First, we're adding the ability to do bulk-deletion of older versions of a document that are no longer used, followed by the ability to distinguish between major and minor versions of a document. These updates will be available with the February release.

## New OData sets for Report Creation

PowerBI and other report engines are great when you want to create your own reports based on data available in Projectplace. To make it even easier to create relevant reports, we will release new OData sets that are aimed towards different types of users.

The first of these new OData sets, scheduled for the February release, will target the Project or Workspace Manager. Through this new data set it will be possible to get all data for the workspaces that the user owns or manages. Reports on activities or cards and their status, who is assigned to what and how much time has been reported are just some of the things that will be easier to summarize.

## Manage Notifications

In 2019 we are planning to make notifications more flexible and adaptable based on how you want to receive notifications about your Projectplace-related work. As a first step, we are introducing the ability to stop receiving notifications on a conversation or comment thread that you previously participated in. More updates will follow shortly.

## Mobile Apps

For our iOS and Android apps users, we are introducing several updates that will make it easier to keep collaboration going when you are on the go. In January, we are introducing the ability to initiate a document review in iOS (this has been available on Android since December 2018), to filter Documents and to see the items you are following in the apps themselves. With the February release, we will support Multiple People Card assignments.

## Other Enhancements

Throughout the quarter, we will also be releasing several minor enhancements and bug fixes. Some of these updates include the introduction of Custom Fields in the Documents filter and automatic setting of Parent Activity status based on the status of its Children.
